Affidavit of notice and demand

YOU, Name of ripoff bank and agent here are hereby given notice that that you have illegally and unlawfully created a fraudulent mortgage contract wherefore it is null and void for the following reasons.

1. You did not loan any lawful money, gold or silver coin. See **Constitution for the united states, article 1, section 10** “No state shall ...make anything but gold and silver coin a tender in payment of debts”... Wherefore there was no valuable consideration tendered and the contract is null and void. And further, Federal Reserve notes have no redeemable value in gold or silver coin and are obligations/debt of the federal corporation, the UNITED STATES. See **TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 1 > § 8** **Obligation or other security of the United States defined** The term “obligation or other security of the United States” includes all bonds, certificates of indebtedness, national bank currency, Federal Reserve notes, Federal Reserve bank notes, coupons,...
2. The contract is also null and void for it was in the commission of a crime. You had compelled the disclosure of my social security number in violation of USC **TITLE 42 > CHAPTER 7 > SUBCHAPTER II > § 408** Penalties
A- (8) **discloses, uses, or compels the disclosure of the social security number of any person in violation of the laws of the United States; shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction thereof shall be fined under title 18 or imprisoned for not more than five years, or both.**

3. Further, you have not produced the original contract or any validation of debt for lawful money, (gold or silver coin). See **USC TITLE 15 > CHAPTER 41 > SUBCHAPTER V > § 1692g Validation of debts**

Regardless of the foregoing, a discharge by Bill of Exchange has been tendered according to articles of law provided and contained within the UCC codes. And further, the FEDERAL RESERVE lawfully has to honor the Bill of Exchange upon endorsement according to **USC TITLE 12 > CHAPTER 3 > SUBCHAPTER IX > § 343.**

And further, your refusal to accept the Bill of Exchange is discharge of debt according to **UCC § 3-603. TENDER OF PAYMENT.(b) If tender of payment of an obligation to pay an instrument is made to a person entitled to enforce the instrument and the tender is refused, there is discharge, to the extent of the amount of the tender, of the obligation of an endorser or accommodation party having a right of recourse with respect to the obligation to which the tender relates.**

Wherefore I demand the immediate closure of the fraudulent account and the release of lien.

And further, you are acting criminally in your refusal of immediate closure of this alleged account and to release the lien upon my property. And further, you are acting criminally in making your unlawful demands. You are in violation of the following laws set forth in the UNITED STATES CODE and have caused injury as valued.

1) **USC TITLE 42 > CHAPTER 7 > SUBCHAPTER II > § 408 Penalties**

A- (8) discloses, uses, or compels the disclosure of the social security number of any person in violation of the laws of the United States; shall be guilty of a felony and upon conviction thereof shall be fined under title 18 or imprisoned for not more than five years, or both.

Wherefore, injury as valued by **TITLE 18 > PART II > CHAPTER 227 > SUBCHAPTER C > § 3571 = \$500,000**

2) **TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 13 > § 241 Conspiracy against rights**

If two or more persons conspire to injure, oppress, threaten, or intimidate any person in any State, Territory, Commonwealth, Possession, or District in the free exercise or enjoyment of any right or privilege secured to him by the Constitution or laws of the United States, or because of his having so exercised the same; or

If two or more persons go in disguise on the highway, or on the premises of another, with intent to prevent or hinder his free exercise or enjoyment of any right or privilege so secured—

They shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than ten years, or both; and if death results from the acts committed in violation of this section or if such acts include kidnapping or an attempt to kidnap, aggravated sexual abuse or an attempt to commit aggravated sexual abuse, or an attempt to kill, they shall be fined under this title or imprisoned for any term of years or for life, or both, or may be sentenced to death.

Wherefore, injury as valued by TITLE 18 > PART II > CHAPTER 227 > SUBCHAPTER C > § 3571 = \$500,000

3) TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 31 > § 656 Theft, embezzlement, or misapplication by bank officer or employee

Whoever, being an officer, director, agent or employee of, or connected in any capacity with any Federal Reserve bank, member bank, depository institution holding company, national bank, insured bank, branch or agency of a foreign bank, or organization operating under section 25 or section 25(a) ^{III} of the Federal Reserve Act, or a receiver of a national bank, insured bank, branch, agency, or organization or any agent or employee of the receiver, or a Federal Reserve Agent, or an agent or employee of a Federal Reserve Agent or of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, embezzles, abstracts, purloins or willfully misapplies any of the moneys, funds or credits of such bank, branch, agency, or organization or holding company or any moneys, funds, assets or securities intrusted to the custody or care of such bank, branch, agency, or organization, or holding company or to the custody or care of any such agent, officer, director, employee or receiver, shall be fined not more than \$1,000,000 or imprisoned not more than 30 years, or both; but if the amount embezzled, abstracted, purloined or misapplied does not exceed \$1,000, he shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

Wherefore, injury as valued by the foregoing is = \$1,000,000

4) TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 42 > § 892 Making extortionate extensions of credit

(a) Whoever makes any extortionate extension of credit, or conspires to do so, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than 20 years, or both.

Wherefore, injury as valued by TITLE 18 > PART II > CHAPTER 227 > SUBCHAPTER C > § 3571 = \$500,000

5) TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 42 > § 893 Financing extortionate extensions of credit

Whoever willfully advances money or property, whether as a gift, as a loan, as an investment, pursuant to a partnership or profit-sharing agreement, or otherwise, to any person, with reasonable grounds to believe that it is the intention of that person to use the money or property so advanced directly or indirectly for the purpose of making extortionate extensions of credit, shall be fined under this title or an amount not exceeding twice the value of the money or property so advanced, whichever is greater, or shall be imprisoned not more than 20 years, or both.

Wherefore, injury as valued by TITLE 18 > PART II > CHAPTER 227 > SUBCHAPTER C > § 3571 = \$500,000

6) TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 42 > § 894 Collection of extensions of credit by extortionate means

(a) Whoever knowingly participates in any way, or conspires to do so, in the use of any extortionate means

(1) to collect or attempt to collect any extension of credit, or

(2) to punish any person for the nonrepayment thereof,

shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than 20 years, or both.

Wherefore, injury as valued by **TITLE 18 > PART II > CHAPTER 227 > SUBCHAPTER C > § 3571 = \$500,000**

7) TITLE 18 > PART I > CHAPTER 95 > § 1951 Interference with commerce by threats or violence

(a) Whoever in any way or degree obstructs, delays, or affects commerce or the movement of any article or commodity in commerce, by robbery or extortion or attempts or conspires so to do, or commits or threatens physical violence to any person or property in furtherance of a plan or purpose to do anything in violation of this section shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than twenty years, or both.

(b) As used in this section—

(1) The term “robbery” means the unlawful taking or obtaining of personal property from the person or in the presence of another, against his will, by means of actual or threatened force, or violence, or fear of injury, immediate or future, to his person or property, or property in his custody or possession, or the person or property of a relative or member of his family or of anyone in his company at the time of the taking or obtaining.

(2) The term “extortion” means the obtaining of property from another, with his consent, induced by wrongful use of actual or threatened force, violence, or fear, or under color of official right.

(3) The term “commerce” means commerce within the District of Columbia, or any Territory or Possession of the United States; all commerce between any point in a State, Territory, Possession, or the District of Columbia and any point outside thereof; all commerce between points within the same State through any place outside such State; and all other commerce over which the United States has jurisdiction.

Wherefore, injury as valued by **TITLE 18 > PART II > CHAPTER 227 > SUBCHAPTER C > § 3571 = \$500,000**

Wherefore all of the foregoing injuries as valued total \$4,000,000.00. (Four million dollars and no cents.)

Wherefore I RIGHTFULLY DEMAND the immediate closure of the alleged account and release of lien and payment for total injuries at the rate of per day beginning ten (10) days after receipt of this Notice and Demand and shall continue at the rate of \$4,000,000.00.

(Four million dollars and no cents.) per day each day thereafter until said closure of these alleged accounts and all liens on (or) against above said property are removed.

NOTICE OF INTENT

YOU are hereby given further NOTICE of Intent to Seek, Commence, Secure, Lien and Recover

in toto, remedy for all damages and to Criminally Prosecute all those responsible under all applicable provisions and Mandates of the Ordained Constitution for the Union of several States of the United States of America, 1789, and Laws made in pursuance thereof.
